<p>New Meeting Structure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proposal to allow meeting time for workgroups (committees) during the regular meeting. Workgroups would be based on our strategic plan. It was suggested that a description of each workgroup be developed and members could decide where their skills best fit. Questions to be addressed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ How do we involve more people? ○ Will there be enough people for the workgroups? ○ what is expected of each group? • What are we missing? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Youth component. How can we effectively involve youth? For example, at Deerfield HS student athletes are involved in leadership initiatives for all sports (2 athletes are invited to participate in a leadership program and they bring it back to their teams). College student involvement? How do we ensure youth voice is part of the collaboration with adults on the Task Force? ○ We need to be careful to identify tasks we have the capacity to do vs. tasks that are beyond our current capacity. We tend to have a larger picture of the county and provide leadership and networking around issue. How do we become a spokesperson for the county?? Can we create a culture of 'why aren't you on board?'
