<p>1. Meeting Structure</p>	<p>Starting in January 2012, we will start each meeting at 8am with committee meetings. The regular meeting will begin at 8:30am. Committees may need to meet outside of this time as well; however ½ hour will be dedicated to committee work. Committee descriptions are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Communication: county-wide awareness campaign; task-force resource sharing; pending funding, a pilot communication campaign in Grayslake • Law and Policy: social host evaluation and training; increase readiness for communities to adopt and use a SHO. • Enforcement: continue reporting alcohol compliance checks, mentoring/training communities that do not do compliance checks; NEW prescription drug collection transfer – developing a process to share responsibility to transport prescription drugs collected via 'Save-A-Star'

	<p>boxes among communities to reduce cost to a single municipality.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sustainability: both human resources and financial resources for the continued work of the Task Force. Funding will allow for easier growth in prevention initiatives. There was much discussion about applying for the next round of DFC funding. As a DFC grantee for 10 yrs., Kris Andersen (LCHD) offered to present information about the grant requirements/benefits/ challenges at the January meeting. Stand Up and Speak Up coalitions also currently have a DFC funding and will offer their insight as well.
