|  | <b>Enforcement</b> (Dep. Chief Rick Wilk and Dep. Chief Steve Husak) <b>Compliance checks will be arranged toward prom/graduation season (mid May/early June)</b>  |
|  | <b>Drug Collection Committee</b> (Dep. Chief Dave Belmonte) <b>They laid out a thumbnail of what they wanted to do. 1. Get information about prescription drug use out. 2. Disposal issue for departments. Lt. Kevin Leslie (Zion) reported on what he has learned from Veolia Env. Services. They will provide 30 gal. barrels, pick up and disposal -\$\$\$. Zion will test to see how long it takes to fill up the barrel and cost/savings compared to driving collected drugs to Indianapolis. Additional issues of disposal will be addressed as well (requiring the separation of pills from bottles, etc). JoAnn Osmond may be some grant money to help with this process. DEA pick up every 6 mo. – next one is the end of April (Beach Park and Deerpark). The committee will find out if collected drugs can be given to the DEA during those collection events. Dave Belmonte will connect with Jeff Norris (Fox Lake) re: next drug collection trip to Indianapolis to include them.</b> |
